- General Contractor must have hold harmless agreement in Insured's favor
  - ◆ Underwriter must approve the GC's carrier and coverage details
- Flexible minimum premium

- Limits up to \$2M Agg/\$1M Occ.
- \$5M Excess capability on most classes
- Flexible minimum premiums
- Company issued policies
- Company ordered inspections and audits
- Flexible deductions
